

Environmental Policy Statement

Future Cleaning Services (South West) recognises its responsibilities with regard to the environment including compliance with the duty of care under Sections 33 and 34 of the Environmental Protection Act.

In order to ensure that it meets its obligations the company will:

- Work with all clients in meeting the objectives of their Environmental Policies
- Identify all waste materials that are produced and ensure that they are removed only by a registered waste carrier to a licensed waste disposal site
- Ensure that all waste disposal contractors used comply with the duty of care
- Ensure that our purchasing policies take into account the environmental impact of the products obtained
- Control energy use and avoid unnecessary consumption of fuel
- Ensure that our operations result in the generation of minimal quantities of waste materials, particularly hazardous waste
- Where practicable re-use waste materials or if they cannot be re-used send them for recycling or reprocessing via a reputable operator
- Take all reasonable precautions to avoid pollution of air, land or water
- Assist regulatory bodies in their work to maintain and improve the environment;
- Keep up to date with current environmental regulations
- Inform all our employees and sub-contractors of this policy and ensure that they work in accordance with its aims and objectives

The policy will be revised and updated at least annually.
